Traditionally men and women cover their heads during prayer • Face the direction of Mecca • White praying generally locus your gaze on the ground where forehead louches the ground • Stand in reverence, and put the world behind you

Ablution (Luminous Purification)

Before the proyers, using clean water in your hands, wash over the following areas three times: lops of the hands tright band first] * Face (also rinse mouth and nostris) * Forearms (right arm first) * Top of the head, bock of the head, and neck * Face (right foot first) to the analites
